1 [PROPOSED] ORDER Defendant Bruce Perens specially moves to strike Plaintiffs' First Amended 2 Complaint under California's anti-SLAPP Statute, California Code of Civil 3 4 Procedure Section 425.16, and moves to dismiss with prejudice Plaintiffs' First Amended Complaint under Federal Rule of Civil Procedure Section 12(b)(6). On 5 December 14, 2017, the Court held a hearing on the motion, with Chhabra Law 6 Firm, PC appearing for Plaintiffs Open Source Security, Inc. and Bradley Spengler, 7 and with O'Melveny & Myers LLP appearing for Defendant. 8 After considering Defendant's moving papers and attached exhibits, 9 opposing and reply papers, arguments of counsel, and all other materials presented 10 to the Court, and good cause appearing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: 11 Defendant's motions to strike Plaintiffs' claims pursuant to 12 California's anti-SLAPP statute and to dismiss the First Amended Complaint 13 pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure Section 12(b)(6) are **GRANTED**. 14 Plaintiffs' First Amended Complaint is hereby dismissed with prejudice. 15 IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Defendant is entitled to 16 reimbursement of his reasonable attorneys' fees in bringing his motions and 17 obtaining dismissal of the action, as provided for by California Code of Civil 18 Procedure Section 425.16 and applicable law.
